Santander Universities Undergraduate Student Global Service Learning Grants Summer 2019

ELIGIBILITY

The Santander Universities Student Global Service Learning Grants are intended to provide Providence College undergraduate students with the financial assistance necessary to participate on the increasing and varied number of international service learning programs or projects and other alternative service engagement projects abroad.

Since these programs are generally non-academic in intent and design, the Santander Grants are intended for global service engagement projects during the summer months.

APPLICATION REVIEW AND CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

**Only complete applications will be reviewed by the Santander Scholarship Selection Committee.*

- Applications are reviewed after the deadline, not on a rolling basis.
- Grant awards may be up to \$2,000 for the service project.
- Student will be performing non-credit-bearing service abroad during the summer of 2019.
- Student is not participating in a Providence College faculty-led program.
- Student must demonstrate knowledge of and commitment to the relevant social issues of the programs mission. Selections will be based on the quality of the proposed project.
- Student may not be performing service in a country that has a U.S. Department of State Travel Warning/Alert or a CDC Travel Health Warning/Alert.
- Preference will be given to students who have not received prior funding from Santander
- Preference will be given to students whose permanent residence is a state in which Banco Santander has branch offices:

*Connecticut
Delaware
Florida
Massachusetts
New Hampshire*

*New Jersey
New York
Pennsylvania
Rhode Island*

- For international students, preference will be given to students whose permanent citizenship is from [a country in which Santander Universities has affiliates](#).

RETURN REQUIREMENT

Scholarship recipients agree to submit, at the conclusion of the program, a 2-4 page statement about their experience abroad, including how it has affected them personally and academically, and how this scholarship supported their endeavors. Students also must submit photographs from their time abroad. Once submitted, this full report becomes property of Providence College and excerpts or photographs may be used on the CGE website, in Providence College electronic and printed publications, or in annual reports on the scholarship program to Banco Santander.
