- Indicate how you wish the course to count towards your degree by indicating a **Type Code***, as listed below.

PLEASE NOTE

- This form <u>stays at PC only</u> it is not sent to your program and does not constitute actual registration for courses. It is for planning and approval purposes only!
- You may not be able to obtain course syllabi until you arrive abroad. This will delay the approval process, but does not preclude course approval or your enrollment in the course.
- You must take the equivalent of at least 15 U.S. credits per semester while abroad, up to a maximum of 18 credits.
- All study abroad courses must be formally approved by Providence College academic departments and/or the Core Curriculum Committee in order to receive credit towards your degree. The Center for International Studies does not approve courses.
