



Santander Study Abroad Diversity Scholarship for Under-Represented Students Traditional Summer or Faculty-Led Maymester 2020

ELIGIBILITY

- The Santander Study Abroad Diversity Scholarship for Under-Represented Students is intended for students who have not traditionally participated in study abroad opportunities. These students include, but are not limited to:
 - Students from Under-Represented Racial and Ethnic Groups
 - First-Generation College Students
 - Students with Physical or Learning Disabilities
 - International Students (F-1 Visa status)
 - <u>Non-Traditional Students</u>
 - Students with High Financial Need

APPLICATION REVIEW AND CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

*Only complete applications will be reviewed by the Santander Scholarship Selection Committee.

- Applications are reviewed after the deadline, not on a rolling basis
- Grant awards may be up to \$2,000 for the Maymester
- Student must meet one or more of the Eligibility Requirements listed above
- Student will be studying abroad on a Providence College faculty-led program during Maymester 2020
- Preference will be given to students who have not received prior funding from Santander
- Preference will be given to students whose permanent residence is a state in which Banco Santander has branch offices:

Connecticut	New Jersey
Delaware	New York
Florida	Pennsylvania
Massachusetts	Rhode Island
New Hampshire	

• For international students, preference will be given to students whose permanent citizenship is from <u>a country in which Santander Universities has affiliates</u>.

RETURN REQUIREMENT

Scholarship recipients agree to submit, at the conclusion of the program, a 2-4 page statement about their experience abroad, including how it has affected them personally and academically, and how this scholarship supported their endeavors. Students also must submit photographs from their time abroad. Once submitted, this full report becomes property of Providence College and excerpts may be used on the CIS website or in any Providence College electronic and printed publications or in annual reports on the scholarship program to Banco Santander.
